Meeting between the EFFA Board, The Cech Podkovaru and the Podkovari.cz on Thursday 10th November 2022 At the Courtyard by Marriott Hotel, Pilsen.

After discussion between the three parties the agreed proposal is;

1. The Executive Board would suggest that both associations join in a unified approach to the relevant government bodies with suggestions for the betterment of the state education system for farriers and its requirements, in the best interests for the welfare of the horse.

2. In the importance of transparency, the Executive Board find it crucial that both The Podkovari.cz and The Cech Podkovaru associations allow an unbiased observer (from the EFFA Accreditation Board) to observe their exams from until such time as their next Re-Accreditation visit is achieved and the visit and report has been approved by the Accreditation Board and the Delegates at the following AGM. The observer will be one and the same person for all visits and will be funded by the Association themselves.

3. The Executive Board expects its members to act in the best interests of EFFA and follow the general rules and to respect the decisions made by the AGM.
